Admissions Requirements


- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution, or international institution equivalent to a U.S. regionally accredited institution, with a grade point average of 3.0 or better.*
- One essay, 500 - 700 words, describing the applicant's specific career goals, objectives, motivation to pursue an advanced degree.
- A professional resume.
- **No GREs or entrance exams required.**

*Students with GPA's between 2.7 and 3.0 may be considered in combination with other admissions criteria.
