### Important Academic Requirements

- A minimum of 60 credits must be considered liberal arts.
- As many as 90 credits may be transferred from various sources including other colleges, military, and standardized testing. The Cornerstone course and no fewer than 27 Public Safety Administration credits including the Capstone course must be completed with Charter Oak.
- A minimum of 15 of the required concentration credits must be at the upper level. Grades of 'C-' and below are not accepted as part of the concentration. All concentrations are subject to faculty approval.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be at the upper level including 15 within the concentration.
