- ^The degree must contain 30 Liberal Arts Credits (usually satisfied by Gen Ed and Science courses), and 30 upper level (junior/senior) credits; 27 credits of nursing plus one 3cr Upper Level gen Ed or Upper Level Elective.
- * Beginning Fall 2023, Any course taken from CT State Community College that is vetted in one of the following Gen Ed Categories, will meet the Gen Ed Category with the same name at COSC: Oral Communication, Arts and Humanities, Written Communication 1 & 2, Historical Knowledge, Scientific Reasoning, Scientific Knowledge/Understanding, Social/Behavioral Science.
- **CT-CCNP graduates will typically complete at least 30 credits at COSC; 24 credits is usually the minimum credits to complete at COSC if the applicant opts to transfer in two (2) courses from another regionally accredited RN-BSN program with grades of 'C' or above. The credits must be equivalent to the content and credit amount offered in one of the required courses (NUR 301 or 310) in the program, subject to approval of the Nursing Director.
